



CLUB PLAYOFF & CHAMPIONSHIP DAY FORMAT for 2025 - 2026 League Round Formats

Monday Morning Senior Mixed League - 16 teams

- 20 games = 4 rounds
 - Round 1 = 7 games (Red & White Divisions)
 - Round 2 = 7 games (Red & White Divisions)
 - Round 3 = 3 games (4 Divisions = A, B, C & D)
 - Round 4 = 3 games (4 Divisions = A, B, C & D)
- At the completion of Round 1
 - Teams ranked 1 - 4 in Red Division stay in Red
 - Teams ranked 5 - 8 in Red Division go into White
 - Teams ranked 1 - 4 in White go into Red
 - Teams ranked 5 - 8 in White Division stay in White
- At the completion of Round 2
 - Teams ranked 1 - 4 in Red Division go into A division
 - Teams ranked 5 - 6 in Red Division go into B division
 - Teams ranked 7 - 8 in Red division go into C Division
 - Teams ranked 1- 2 in White division go into B division
 - Teams ranked 3 - 4 in White division go into C division
 - Teams ranked 5 - 8 in White division go into D division
- At the completion of Round 3 & 4, the top ranked team in B,C & D advance up a division while the bottom ranked team of each division (A,B & C) move down a division.
- Playoff positions shall be determined after all of the teams have been reseeded after the final round.
- During the first round, teams will complete a Draw Shot Challenge (DSC) at the end of a game to assist in the event of ties in a Round ranking.
- The Grand Aggregate Winner and the next best team from Division A go to the Club Playoff Championships. Teams in A & B are ranked 1st - 8th. Should a team not be able to roster a team, the next ranked team will be notified of the playoff spot and so on.
- The top 2 teams from Division C go to the President Playoff Championships. Teams in C & D are ranked 9th - 16th. Should a team not be able to roster a team, the next ranked team will be notified of the playoff spot and so on.

Monday Night Mixed - 16 teams

- 21 games = 3 rounds
 - Round 1 = Full round of 15 games
 - Round 2 = Round robin of 3 games (4 Divisions)
 - Round 3 = Round robin of 3 games (4 Divisions)

- At the completion of Round 1
 - Teams ranked 1 - 4 go into Division A1
 - Teams ranked 5 - 8 go into Division A2
 - Teams ranked 9 - 12 go into Division B1
 - Teams ranked 13 - 16 go into Division B2
- At the completion of Round 2
 - The top ranked team in A2,B1 & B2 advance up a division while the bottom ranked team of each division (A1,A2 & B1) move down a division.
- During the first round, teams will complete a Draw Shot Challenge (DSC) at the end of a game to assist in the event of ties in a round ranking
- **Continued for 2025/2026 season** - Playoff positions shall be determined after all of the teams have been reseeded upon completion of the final third round robin game.
- A Grand Aggregate Winner is the League Champion. The Grand Aggregate is the team with the most total points accumulated during the entire league season (all Rounds) and is in Division A1 for Round 3.
- **Continued for 2025/26 season - Mixed league will be sending 4 teams to the Clubs Championship and 4 teams to the President Playoff Championships.**
- The Grand Aggregate Winner and the next best 3 teams from Division A go to the Club Playoff Championships. Teams in A1 & A2 are ranked 1st - 8th. Should a team not be able to roster a team, the next ranked team will be notified of the playoff spot and so on.
- The top 4 teams from Division B1 to the President Playoff Championships. Teams in B1 & B2 are ranked 9th - 16th. Should a team not be able to roster a team, the next ranked team will be notified of the playoff spot and so on.

Monday Night Mixed Doubles - 12 teams

- 21 games = 3 rounds
 - Round 1 = Full round of 11 games
 - Round 2 = 2 Division round robin of 5 games
 - Round 3 = 2 Division round robin of 5 games
- At the completion of Round 1
 - Teams ranked 1st - 6th go into Division A
 - Teams ranked 7th - 12th go into Division B
- At the completion of Round 2
 - The top ranked two teams in B division advance up to A division while the bottom two ranked teams of Division A move down to B division.
- During the first round, teams will complete a Draw Shot Challenge (DSC) at the end of a game to assist in the event of ties in a round ranking.
- Playoff positions shall be determined after all of the teams have been reseeded upon completion of the final third round robin game.
- A Grand Aggregate Winner is the League Champion. The Grand Aggregate is the team with the most total points accumulated during the entire league season (all Rounds) and is in Division A for Round 3.
- The Grand Aggregate Winner and the Doubles will have league Grand Aggregate 'A' division vs 'A' Winner of the last Round to Advance to Club Championship Day Final.

Tuesday Morning Ladies - 16 teams

- 21 games =
 - Round 1 = Full round of 15 games
 - Round 2 = Round robin of 3 games (4 Divisions)
 - Round 3 = Round robin of 3 games (4 Divisions)

- At the completion of Round 1
 - Teams ranked 1st - 4th go into Division A1
 - Teams ranked 5th - 8th go into Division A2
 - Teams ranked 9th - 12th go into Division B1
 - Teams ranked 13th - 16th go into Division B2
- At the completion of Round 2
 - The top ranked team in A2,B1 & B2 advance up a division while the bottom ranked team of each division (A1,A2 & B1) move down a division.
- During the first round, teams will complete a Draw Shot Challenge (DSC) at the end of a game to assist in the event of ties in a round ranking.
- Playoff positions shall be determined after all of the teams have been reseeded upon completion of the final third round robin game.
- A Grand Aggregate Winner is the League Champion. The Grand Aggregate is the team with the most total points accumulated during the entire league season (all Rounds) and is in Division A1 for Round 3.
- 2 spots awarded for Club Championships and 2 for President.
- The Grand Aggregate Winner and the next best team from Division A1 go to the Club Playoff Championships. Teams in A1 & A2 are ranked 1st - 8th. Should a team not be able to roster a team, the next ranked team will be notified of the playoff spot and so on.
- The top 2 teams from Division B1 to the President Playoff Championships. Teams in B1 & B2 are ranked 9th - 16th. Should a team not be able to roster a team, the next ranked team will be notified of the playoff spot and so on.

Tuesday Night Mens - 28 teams

- 21 games = 3 rounds of 7 games
- 4 Divisions = A - 8 teams, B - 8 teams, C - 6 teams and D - 6 teams.
- At the end of each round, top 2 teams of each division (B,C & D) advance up a division while the bottom 2 teams of each division (A,B & C) move down a division.
- During the first round, teams will complete a Draw Shot Challenge (DSC) at the end of a game to assist in the event of ties in a round ranking.
- Playoff positions shall be determined after all of the teams have been reseeded upon completion of the final third round robin game.
- All teams advance to the first round of playoffs.
- The Men's Leagues champions are determined through a playoff system for both Men's leagues. The eight teams in A division, after the third round of seeding, will play in a modified double knockout tournament, to determine the champion of each league, who will then advance to the Club Championships playoffs.

Wednesday Morning Senior Mixed League - 16 teams

- 20 games = 4 rounds
 - Round 1 = 7 games (Red & White Divisions)
 - Round 2 = 7 games (Red & White Divisions)
 - Round 3 = 3 games (4 Divisions = A, B, C & D)
 - Round 4 = 3 games (4 Divisions = A, B, C & D)
- At the completion of Round 1
 - Teams ranked 1 - 4 in Red Division stay in Red
 - Teams ranked 5 - 8 in Red Division go into White
 - Teams ranked 1 - 4 in White go into Red
 - Teams ranked 5 - 8 in White Division stay in White

- At the completion of Round 2
 - Teams ranked 1 - 4 in Red Division go into A division
 - Teams ranked 5 - 6 in Red Division go into B division
 - Teams ranked 7 - 8 in Red division go into C Division
 - Teams ranked 1- 2 in White division go into B division
 - Teams ranked 3 - 4 in White division go into C division
 - Teams ranked 5 - 8 in White division go into D division
- At the completion of Round 3 & 4, the top ranked team in B,C & D advance up a division while the bottom ranked team of each division (A,B & C) move down a division.
- Playoff positions shall be determined after all of the teams have been reseeded after the final round.
- During the first round, teams will complete a Draw Shot Challenge (DSC) at the end of a game to assist in the event of ties in a Round ranking.
- The Grand Aggregate Winner and the next best team from Division A go to the Club Playoff Championships. Teams in A & B are ranked 1st - 8th. Should a team not be able to roster a team, the next ranked team will be notified of the playoff spot and so on.

- Playoff positions shall be determined after all of the teams have been reseeded upon completion of the final third round robin game.
- 3 spots awarded for Club Championships and 3 for President.
- The top 3 teams from Division A go to the Club Playoff Championships. Teams ranked 1st - 8th. Should a team not be able to roster a team, the next ranked team will be notified of the playoff spot and so on.
- The top 3 teams from Division B to the President Playoff Championships. Teams ranked 9th - 16th. Should a team not be able to roster a team, the next ranked team will be notified of the playoff spot and so on.

- 21 games = 3 rounds of 7 games.
- At the end of each round, top 2 teams of each division (B,C & D) advance up a division while the bottom 2 teams of each division (A,B & C) move down a division.
- During the first round, teams will complete a Draw Shot Challenge (DSC) at the end of a game to assist in the event of ties in a round ranking.
- Playoff positions shall be determined after all of the teams have been reseeded upon completion of the final third round robin game.
- All teams advance to the first round of playoffs.
- The Men's Leagues champions are determined through a playoff system for both Men's leagues. The eight teams in A division, after the third round of seeding, will play off in a modified double knockout tournament, to determine the champion of each league, who will then advance to the Club Championships playoffs.

Friday Morning Senior Mixed League - 16 teams (FALL)

- 10 games = 2 rounds
 - Round 1 = 7 games (Red & White Divisions)
 - Round 2 = 3 games (4 Divisions = A, B, C & D)
- At the completion of Round 1
 - Teams ranked 1 & 2 in Red & White Division go into A division
 - Teams ranked 3 & 4 in Red & White Division go into B division
 - Teams ranked 5 & 6 in Red & White Division go into C Division
 - Teams ranked 7 & 8 in Red & White Division go into D Division
- During the first round, teams will complete a Draw Shot Challenge (DSC) at the end of a game to assist in the event of ties in a Round ranking.
- The League champion is the team with the most total points accumulated during the entire league season (all Rounds) and is in Division A for Round 2.
- This league does not advance to the Club Championships playoffs.

Friday Morning Senior Mixed League - TBD teams (WINTER 2026)

- 9 games = 2 rounds
 - Round 1 = X games (Red & White Divisions - dependent on number of teams)
 - Round 2 = X games (X divisions = tbd)
- This league does not advance to the Club Championships playoffs.

Friday Night Mixed League - 26 teams

- 21 games = 3 rounds of 7 games.
- 4 Divisions = A - 8 teams, B - 6 teams, C - 6 teams and D - 6 teams.
- At the end of each round, top 2 teams of each division (B,C & D) advance up a division while the bottom 2 teams of each division (A,B & C) move down a division.
- During the first round, teams will complete a Draw Shot Challenge (DSC) at the end of a game to assist in the event of ties in a Round ranking.
- Continued for 2025/2026 season - Playoff positions shall be determined after all of the teams have been reseeded upon completion of the final third round robin game.
- A Grand Aggregate Winner is the League Champion. The Grand Aggregate is the team with the most total points accumulated during the entire league season (all Rounds) and is in Division A for Round 3.

- Playoff positions shall be determined after all of the teams have been reseeded upon completion of the final round robin game.
- A Grand Aggregate Winner is the League Champion. The Grand Aggregate is the team with the most total points accumulated during the entire league season (all rounds).
- The Grand Aggregate Winner and the next best team from Division go to the Club Playoff Championships Day.

Sunday Open - 15 Teams

- 18 games =
 - Round 1 = Full round of 15 games
 - Round 2 = Round robin of 3 games (4 Divisions)
- During the first round, teams will complete a Draw Shot Challenge (DSC) at the end of a game to assist in the event of ties in a round ranking.
- Playoff positions shall be determined after all of the teams have been reseeded upon completion of the final round robin game.
- A Grand Aggregate Winner is the League Champion. The Grand Aggregate is the team with the most total points accumulated during the entire league season (all rounds) and is in the A Division.
- The Grand Aggregate Winner and the next best team from Division A go to the Club Playoff Championships Day.
