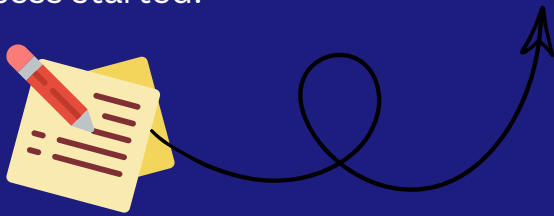


## Notes for Next Season

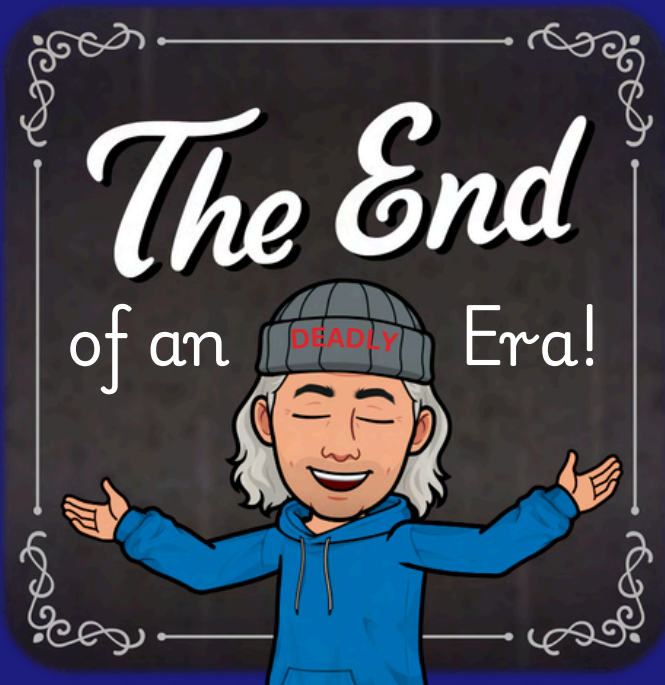


## Tribute to the King of the Ice
