

A Note about Dividers from the SPCC Executive

For the 2022/2023 season, the SPCC Board decided to NOT install the Dividers between the curling sheets.

This decision was reviewed at the April 23, 2023 Board meeting (as requested) and a motion to not install dividers for the 2023/2024 season was approved. The following points were discussed.

- With dividers in place, scraping the ice is more difficult and ice quality is affected. The resulting ice quality is better if the dividers are not in place.
- Ice team time and cost to maintain the ice are reduced.
- Without dividers, we all need to pay attention and keep rocks on our sheets. This may be an annoyance or a safety concern to some. However, to some the dividers in place were also a safety concern (tripping hazard).
- Each year the foam dividers are somewhat damaged during the year ending ice removal process and eventually would require replacement (added cost).

Together we can successfully curl on our ice surface. We appreciate your cooperation as we continue providing high quality ice conditions for play.
