

## **2021 SPCC Junior Classic, Nov 12-14**

### **Event Information**

Welcome back curlers, coaches and parents. We are very happy to be hosting the 2021 SPCC Junior Classic. This document is filled with all the non-competition information about our event.

#### **Health Guidelines / REP / Vaccination Requirements**

Our club is located inside the Glen Allan Recreation Complex, which is a Strathcona County facility. Everyone 18 and over will be required to provide proof of vaccination and photo ID (or proof of a negative test) at the front entrance.

All players must check in at the club entrance with their proof of vaccination and photo ID (or proof of a negative test) before the start of their first game. Please allow extra time for this process. The SPCC has its own vaccination policy and requires proof of vaccination from all visitors/players 12 and over.

Anyone 12 or older must be prepared to show proof of vaccination and government ID, to enter the SPCC Lounge and viewing area.

Masks are required at all times except while:

1. participating in physical activity on ice. Coaches must remain masked while on the ice surface.
2. eating/drinking in the Lounge. Spectators must remain seated while eating/drinking.

#### **Locker Room Area**

The SPCC locker room is an Athletes and Coaches zone only. Parents who want to chat with their curlers must make arrangements to do so in the main area of the building or our lounge. The locker area is not a change room. Any curlers needing to change clothing, can use the main facility locker room which is located to the left of the front reception desk.

#### **Stretching/Warm Up Area**

For any teams wanting to warm up/stretch outside the SPCC locker area, Studio 206 is available to you. (Up the stairs, turn right). Please do not use the GARC building's main area as there is also a ringette tournament taking place throughout the weekend.

#### **Spectators**

As we are complying with the REP, we do not have any restrictions on the number of spectators allowed in the SPCC lounge other than Fire Code. As above, all lounge visitors age 12 and over must be prepared to show proof of vaccination and photo ID.

While we will be updating scores on Curling Zone and posting content on our social media channels, the club will not be livestreaming any games. Teams are welcome to bring their own streaming devices so long as they do not obstruct the view of other spectators. Public WIFI is available. Power outlets are limited but available. Please bring your own extension cords, as the outlets are located at ceiling height, and be prepared to share with your neighbours.
